



Percent of Adults Completing College in Appalachia, 1990

Compared with the U.S. Average



The college completion rate is the percentage of adults, 25 years and over, completing 4 years of college or more. The percent of the U.S. average is computed by dividing the county college completion rate by the national average and multiplying by 100.

Percent of the U.S. Average



U.S. average = 20.3%
Appalachian average = 14.3%
