Industrial snapshot: Appalachian Ohio

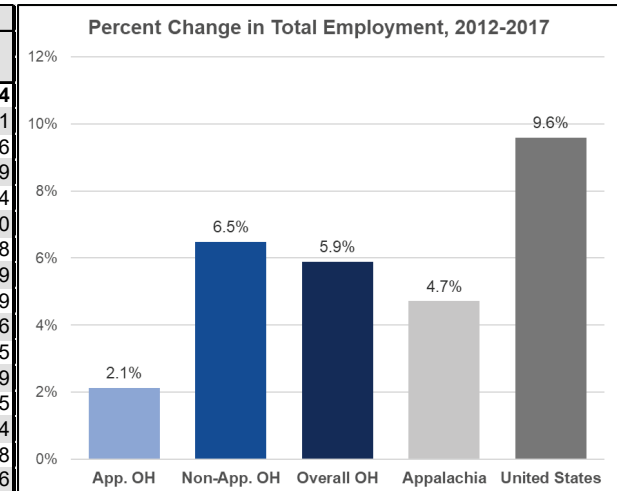
Largest industrial share in 2017: **Health & Social Services**, 121,000 jobs, 13.2 percent of total employment
