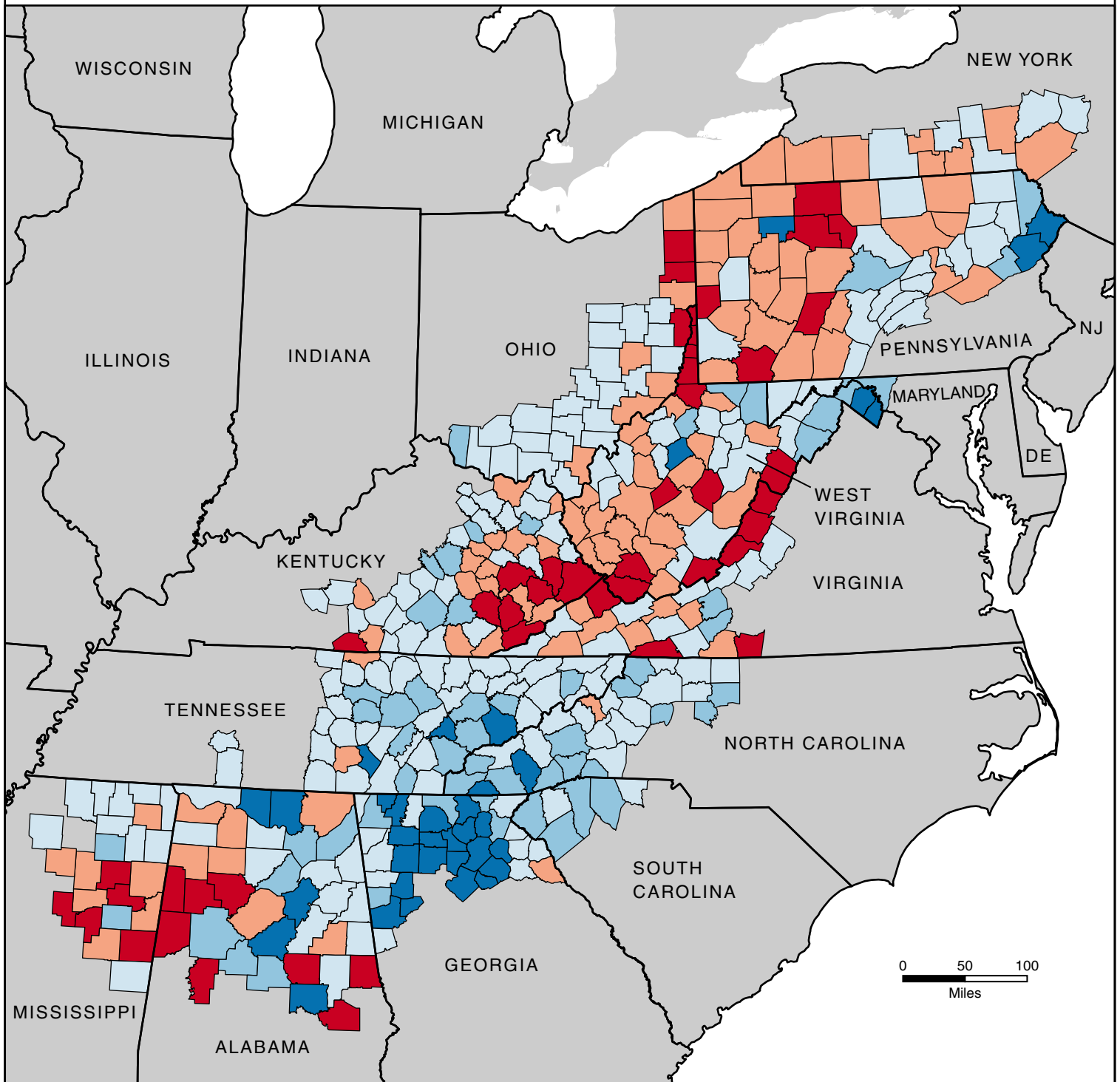


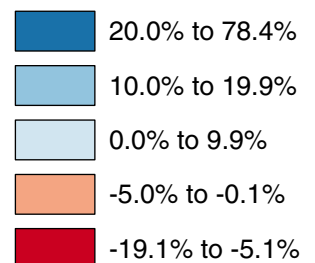
Population Change in Appalachia, 2000–2010

(Population Change as a Percentage of the 2000 Population)



Population change is the difference between the 2000 population and the 2010 population expressed as a percentage of the 2000 population.

Population Change



U.S. average = 9.7%
Appalachian average = 6.8%
