## **PROJECT SUMMARY**

The Pennsylvania Environmental Council will use ARISE funding to develop a plan to connect multi-use trails throughout Appalachian New York, Pennsylvania, and the Seneca Nation of Indians. While these trails already drive tourism to the region, this project will facilitate collaboration across state and municipal lines to create a cohesive strategy to further increase regional economic growth, community well-being, and outdoor recreation access.

The Pennsylvania Environmental Council will provide \$72,219 in matching funds to the project. The project will result in one comprehensive plan at the end of the one-year performance period.
